AHI's Clear the Air in the Southern Adirondacks Program Launches New Website, Social Media Pages

AHI's <u>Clear the Air in the Southern Adirondack (CASA)</u> program has launched a new website and social media pages to promote its mission of building healthier communities through tobacco-free living.



CASA is an advancing tobacco-free communities
partnership grant funded by the New York State
Department of Health Bureau of Tobacco Control and serves Warren, Washington, and Saratoga counties.

CASA's goal is to reduce the impact of retail tobacco marketing on youth and adults, establish a tobacco-free community norm through tobacco-free outdoor air and housing policies, and decrease tobacco imagery in youth-related movies and the tobacco industry's presence on social media.



The new website features information on the program's four key initiatives - retail environment/point-of-sale, tobacco-free outdoors, tobacco-free multi-unit housing, and smoke-free movies. In addition, the site spotlights Reality Check, a free youth-led, adult-supported CASA initiative involving those 13-18 years of age who lead positive change in their communities through the education of business leaders, legislators, and

other community representatives and entities. The site also includes resources, news and updates, a list of upcoming events, and more.

Coinciding with the website launch, the program has also unveiled new Facebook and Instagram pages, along with a new YouTube Channel. The program will use these pages as vehicles to help promote their mission and encourage community participation in its activities.

The Ticonderoga Health Center has relocated to a newly renovated building and is now open and accepting patients. A joint venture of <u>Hudson Headwaters Health Network</u> and the <u>University of Vermont Health Network - Elizabethtown</u> <u>Community Hospital</u>, the new health center, located on the UVMHN - ECH Ticonderoga Campus, offers patients convenient access to primary care. The new site also offers laboratory and radiology services, physical therapy and sports rehabilitation, and has an emergency room and long-term care facility.

CMS Issues Roadmap to Accelerate Adoption of Value-Based Care to Improve Quality for Medicaid Beneficiaries

Earlier this week, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) issued guidance to state Medicaid directors designed to advance the adoption of value-based care strategies across their health care systems and align provider incentives across payers. Under value-based care, providers are reimbursed based on their ability to improve quality of care in a cost-effective manner or lower costs while maintaining standards of care, rather than the volume of care they provide.

This guidance includes an assessment of key lessons learned from early state and federal experiences in implementing value-based care reforms, as well as a comprehensive toolkit of available federal authorities for states to adopt innovative payment reform efforts within their individual programs.

Medicaid: Expanded income guidelines for 2020. You may qualify if you are an individual making less than \$17,609 annually.



Child Health Plus: Regardless of income, every child is eligible to apply with NO co-pays or deductibles.

Essential Plan: Available for lower income individuals and families who don't qualify for Medicaid. Medical-only coverage has a monthly premium of \$20. Medical/Dental/Vision coverage has a premium of \$40. Depending on income, there may be zero premium/zero copays!

Essential Plan Guidelines:

Family of 1.... Max Household Income = \$25,520 Family of 2.... Max Household Income = \$34,480 Family of 3.... Max Household Income = \$43,440 Family of 4.... Max Household Income = \$52,400 Family of 5.... Max Household Income = \$61,360
