FCC Establishes \$3.2 Billion Emergency Broadband Program

The Federal Communications
Commission (FCC) has
established the Emergency
Broadband Benefit Program, a
\$3.2 billion federal initiative to
help lower the cost of high-speed
internet for eligible households
during the ongoing COVID-19
pandemic.



Among other benefits, the temporary program provides a monthly discount for broadband internet services, and a one-time discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet purchased through a participating provider.
