Citizen Advocates Establishing Charitable Foundation

Latest initiative will bolster causes in six-county region of Northern NY

MALONE, N.Y. – Citizen Advocates is taking the lead on a new initiative by establishing a charitable Foundation to support key causes that advance the health and wellness of communities spanning a six-county region of Northern New York.

The Foundation will operate as a separate and distinct organization with the goal of supporting worthwhile charitable causes in counties where Citizen Advocates currently has a presence: Franklin, Clinton, St. Lawrence, Jefferson, Essex and Hamilton counties.

In addition to new opportunities for charitable giving, the Foundation will continue supporting causes championed by Citizen Advocates, including, but not limited to:

- Backpack Programs in Franklin and St. Lawrence counties
- Local YMCAs
- Watertown Urban Mission
- Adirondack Health
- Alice Hyde Medical Center
- Hospice of the North Country
- Small Town Pride
- Out of Darkness Suicide Prevention Walk

Leading the newly formed Foundation is Jennifer Bilow, who was named as its first Executive Director in January, following an extensive and competitive search process. A North Country native, she is very familiar with Citizen Advocates having previously served on the organization's Board of Directors for three years.

Key duties of the Executive Director include:

- Leading fundraising campaigns
- Planning charitable events
- Cultivating & distributing major gifts

"As a Board Member, I was always impressed with the extent to which Citizen Advocates focused on making lives better both through its services and programs, but also by generously giving to a wide range of causes in the community," said Ms. Bilow. "Now, we have this amazing opportunity to elevate the work we do through a Foundation by helping those we support on a much greater scale throughout the region."
