NY State of Health Releases 2023 Health Insurance Update, Enrollment Totals Continue to Rise with Nearly 7 Million New Yorkers Covered Through the Marketplace

NY State of Health, the state's official health plan Marketplace, released the 2023 Health Insurance Coverage Update, a detailed summary of NY State Health Enrollment, including demographics, quality measures, and the cost savings realized by millions of New Yorkers who have comprehensive health insurance through the Marketplace. As of January 31, 2023, shows that NY State of Health enrollment is nearly 6.9 million, or more than one in three New Yorkers across the state.

Now that updated federal regulations are ending continuous coverage provisions for public health insurance programs, renewal notices will be sent to Medicaid, Child Health Plus (CHPlus), and Essential Plan enrollees, with their deadline to renew or risk a gap in coverage. The Marketplace is making every effort to keep New Yorkers enrolled in health insurance as the redetermination process commences.
