## Continued Need to Address Tobacco and e-Cigarette Usage in the North Country

Tobacco and e-cigarette use continue to be a primary health concern across New York State and throughout the Southern Adirondacks. Shockingly, the adult smoking rate for Washington county is 22.7% and 21.3% in neighboring Warren county. Thankfully, the New York Youth Tobacco Survey found a generation-long decline in cigarette smoking among middle and high school students, dropping from 27.1% to 2.1%. E-cigarette usage is also declining from 27.4% in 2018 to 18.7% in 2022 -- a 32% drop. These are encouraging trends, but there is a continued need to for education and community engagement to address tobacco and e-cigarette use in our local communities.

Recently, **Christopher Bradley**. Clear the Air in the Southern Adirondacks' (CASA) Community Engagement Specialist, spoke with Spectrum News about his past experience with e-cigarettes. His experience, which is all too commonplace among youth and adults alike, led him to quit and ultimately to advocate for tobacco-free communities.

Health care providers and the <u>New York State Smokers' Quitline</u> provide support to smokers who want to quit, and quitting leads to fewer smokers, the potential for better health outcomes and reduced health care costs. When health care providers treat nicotine addiction with medication and counseling, it can double or even triple their patients' chances of success.\* The New York State Smokers' Quitline is a free and confidential service for all New York State residents who wish to overcome use of commercial tobacco and/or vape products. Participants can receive individualized coaching and assistance with quit planning from highly trained tobacco treatment specialists, text and online chat support, and a free starter supply delivery of nicotine replacement therapy medications such as patches, gum and/or lozenges for those 18 and older.
